WHEREAS, Dr. Troy Nash, a distinguished Kansas City native, mentor, and co-founder of The Nash Group, has been appointed Director of the Lewis White Real Estate Center at the University of Missouri–Kansas City; and,

WHEREAS, this appointment is historic, as Dr. Nash becomes the first African American to hold this position since the Center's founding, marking a milestone in the advancement of diversity and leadership within higher education and the real estate industry; and,

WHEREAS, Dr. Nash's journey from public housing to a partner in one of Missouri's top ten commercial real estate firms exemplifies perseverance, vision, and generational uplift, inspiring countless individuals across our community; and,


