The Legislature did not hold a closed meeting.

Dennis Waits, County Legislator, said he has received numerous calls regarding the inadequacy of fire protection in the Blue Summit area, an unincorporated part of the county solely in his district. This area is served by the Inter City Fire Protection District which is a volunteer fire department. He has discussed this issue with the County Counselor's Office and it is his understanding that all volunteer fire departments go through the State Fire Marshall. The County Counselor is responding to the concerns of individuals. Neither Kansas City nor Independence fire departments are required to go to Blue Summit and fight fires even though they have done so in the past.

Ronald E. Finley, County Legislator, asked if there are mutual aide agreements with other entities. Dennis Waits said he doesn't believe so.

Victor E. Callahan, Chairman, suggested discussing this matter in the Land Use Committee Meeting.

Troy Thomas, Manager of Finance, said that the budget will be ready on November 15, 1999.

Victor E. Callahan asked members of the Legislature to let him know prior to next Monday if they will be able to attend a budget hearing on Thursday, November 18, 1999. He will send out a tentative schedule and all budget hearings will be held in Kansas City.
