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4 HEARINGS

The County Legislature held a public hearing regarding the property tax rates of Jackson County, Missouri, Board of Services for the Developmentally Disabled (Sheltered Workshop), the Community Mental Health Fund and the Merchants and Manfacturers' Inventory Replacement. (Ordinances #4353 - #4356)

Dennis Waits opened the public hearing.

Bruce Eddy, Executive Director of the Jackson County Community Mental Health Fund, said each year he comes before the County Legislature to talk about the important role the Community Mental Health Fund plays in the well being of Jackson County citizens. Like the County Legislature, the Mental Health Fund is accountable to our taxpayers. Mr. Eddy explained that they audit each of their contracts and adhere to high standards for licensing and outcome. Mental health levy funds are not an entitlement but instead they are earbed based on performance. He thanked the County Executive and Legislature because they understand and are very supportive.

Mary Ellen Shade, President and CEO of Gillis Center, the oldest child and family serving organization in Kansas City, spoke on behalf of the 35 organizations that receive mental health levy funds. She wanted the County Legislature to know how important the funds are and how much they are appreciated.
