5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Katheryn Shields, County Executive, stated that Jackson County's first rotating recycling center will open this weekend in Raytown at the Joe Herndon Area Vocational Technical Center, 1/4th mile east of Raytown Road on Highway 350. The ceremony will begin at 8:00 a.m. Saturday, November 18, 1995.

The Raytown Recycling Center will be open the 1st and 3rd full weekends of the month.

Grain Valley Recycling Center will be open the 2nd full weekend of the month beginning November 26, 1995. The location is Grain Valley High School located at I-70 and Buckner-Tarsney Road.

The Lake Lotawana Recycling Center will be open the 4th weekend of the month beginning December 9, 1995. The location is the Mason School located at Colbern Road and 7 Highway.

Hours at all centers are Saturday and Sunday from 8:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.

Katheryn Shields, also advised the Legislature that the County Counselor's office has prepared an ordinance establishing the COMBAT Commission. Chairman Tindall said he will sponsor the legislation and the Legislature will present names of members to the County Executive.
