WHEREAS, the Prosecuting Attorney recommends the execution of Cooperative Agreements with the following artists at the rates indicated, to serve as artist-mentors for the MyARTS program, at an actual aggregate cost to the County not to exceed \$16,800.00:

WHEREAS, the MyARTS program exposes high risk youth to a variety of possible work opportunities through a 72-hour apprenticeship, followed by a paid, part-time entrepreneurship position; and,

WHEREAS, the artist-mentors will provide training through the MyARTS apprenticeship


program in the areas of entrepreneurship, business law, accounting, sales, promotions/marketing, and research; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, MO, that the County Executive be and hereby is authorized to execute agreements with Michele Bridges of Kansas City, KS, Andrea Yates of Shawnee, KS, and Meg Chamberlain of Sugar Creek, MO, at an actual aggregate cost to the County not to exceed \$16,800.00, in a form to be approved by the County Counselor; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the agreements.



COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT entered into this 20 day of November, 2008, by and between **JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI**, hereinafter referred to as "the County," and **ANDREA YATES**, 11911 West 49th Street, Shawnee, KS 66216, hereinafter referred to as "Artist Mentor."

WHEREAS, by Resolution 16737, dated October 20, 2008, the Legislature did authorize the execution of an agreement with an Artist Mentor for the MyARTS program as recommended by the Prosecuting Attorney; and,

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the terms and provisions herein contained, the County and the Artist Mentor respectively promise, covenant, and agree with each other as follows:

1. **Services**. The Artist Mentor agrees to provide mentoring services as set forth in the job description and budget, attached hereto as Exhibit A.
2. **Payment**. The County shall pay Artist Mentor on a monthly basis, at the hourly rate of \$20.00 per hour, in a total amount not to exceed \$5,600.00 during the contract period. Payment shall be made upon the County's receipt of Artist Mentor's monthly invoice detailing services rendered.
3. **Terms**. This Agreement shall be effective as of October 1, 2008, and shall terminate December 31, 2008.
4. **Compliance**. Artist Mentor agrees that it will at all times comply with all conditions of this Agreement and will utilize County's funds solely in connection with this Agreement and Exhibit A. No payment shall be made if Artist Mentor is out of compliance

on any other County contract or County ordinance.

5. **Assignability.** Artist Mentor shall not assign the performance of any services to be provided under this Agreement without the written consent of the County.

6. **Liability and Indemnification.** No party to this Agreement shall assume any liability for the acts of any other party to this Agreement, its officers or employees. Artist Mentor shall indemnify, defend and hold County harmless from any and all claims, liabilities, damages, and costs (including reasonable attorney's fees directly related thereto) including but not limited to violation of civil rights and/or bodily injury to or death of any person and for damage to or destruction of property if and to the extent caused by the negligence, willful misconduct or omissions of Artist Mentor during the performance of this Agreement.

7. **Default and Termination.** If Artist Mentor shall default in the performance or observation of any term, or condition of this Agreement, the County shall give Artist Mentor written notice setting forth the default. If said default shall continue by Artist Mentor for 10 days after receipt of the notice, the County may at its election terminate the contract and withhold any payments not yet made to Artist Mentor. Said election shall not in any way limit the County's rights to seek other legal redress and this Agreement may be terminated by the County upon thirty (30) days written notice.


8. **Conflict of Interest.** The Artist Mentor expressly warrants that no officer or employee of the County, whether elected or appointed, shall in any manner whatsoever be interested in or receive any benefit from the profits and emoluments of this Agreement with the knowledge of the Artist Mentor.

9. **Incorporation.** This Agreement and the attached Exhibit A incorporate the entire understanding and agreement of the parties.






