#### SCHEDULING PRE-EMPLOYMENT EXAMINATIONS AND ESSENTIAL FUNCTION TESTING Appointments

In an effort to minimize the least amount of time a candidate will spend in the clinic, appointments are preferred for patient priority. Currently, Jackson County Government schedules appointments for Post-Offer Essential Function Testing and Examinations. Employers are notified of no-show appointments.

#### Appointment Preparation/Paperwork

New hire examination forms and registration forms can be printed by CorporateCare and provided to employer to streamline the information presented to new hire candidates and minimize time spent in the clinic. Especially important for Post-Offer Essential Function Testing, a "What To Expect and How to Prepare for Essential Function Testing" form is available for distribution to new hire candidates, by employer, as this educational information helps to eliminate potential disqualification for elevated blood pressure or medical history concerns. PDF versions of all forms can be provided to employer.

#### Appointment and Examination Timelines

- Average time between arrival and visit with physician or physical therapist = 20 minutes. Primarily due to filling out patient registration and medical history forms.
- Post-Offer Essential Function Test: Applicant will spend an average of 45 to 60-minutes with Physical Therapist to accomplish review of Medical History, Blood Pressure, and Range of Motion pre-test before starting Post-Offer Essential Function Test.
- Pre-Employment Examination: Applicant will spend an average of 30-minutes with physician and nurse to accomplish examination and required ancillary testing.
- Patient arrival and departure time is electronically captured via time stamp. CorporateCare's Occupational Health software provides time analysis reporting for evaluation and quality assurance.
