Urban Prevention Coalition (UPC) presents

Youth Speak-out Against Violence Community Forum

A Youth Speak Out Against Violence Community Forum will be held April 22, 2017 at Southeast High School. The focus of the forum will be on listening to high school youth regarding their challenges with alcohol, drugs and violence in their communities from their perspective. The results of the success of this forum will help organizers determine the viability of repeating the process in other school districts.

What we expect to obtain from this forum is two-fold, first to gain a better understanding of the problem areas youth face from their perspective, and second, to improve relationships with youth and adults as it pertains to the community at large. Social Service agencies will be on hand to provide support as needed.

It is the mission of the Urban Prevention Coalition to create a healthy Jackson County by educating individuals, empowering communities and connecting coalitions to resources surrounding issues of alcohol, drugs and violence.

Goals and objectives:

We envision a community united by people willing to collaborate in creating a healthy and drugfree Jackson County beginning with its youth by:

- A. Educating community members and coalitions to be able to identify and address their needs in relation to underage crime and substance abuse;
- B. Empowering neighborhoods and other coalitions to be able to provide quality services to their community members to reduce underage engagement in risky behavior and;
- C. Offer opportunities for collaboration of ideas, programs and services in an effort to unite Jackson County as a whole.

UPC held its last Prevention Conference in 2013 at Penn Valley Community College. The conference underscored the fact that there was no true prevention network in the Urban Core. As a result the UPC was established in partnership with First Call, a Missouri Division of Alcohol and Drug Abuse Regional Support Center which serves as the fiscal agent for the effort.

The UPC has now been revitalized and refocused. It was registered with the State of Missouri in February, 2015 and has been building capacity ever since.

Co-organizers of the Youth Speak Out Against Violence are the Kansas City Police Department's OK Mentoring Program, the Kansas City Public School District, Jackson County COMBAT and First Call.
