The Road and Bridge Division of Public Works has developed a list of surplus equipment and vehicles.

The Kansas City Zoo has requested two (2) pickup type vehicles be donated to the zoo. Two (2) pickups were chosen from our surplus list that seemed appropriate for their use, and their staff has looked them over. They would appreciate us donating these vehicles to them.

The estimated value of these vehicles are less than \$3,000 each. The Public Works Department recommends that pickup truck numbers P2141, and P2124 be declared surplus and be donated to the Kansas City Zoo.
