# 5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Katheryn Shields, County Executive, reported that an altercation took place at the Detention Center last weekend leaving one inmate in the hospital with serious head trauma. His condition is improving and the other inmate has been placed in lockdown. An investigation is taking place.

She reminded everyone that they are invited to the dedication of The Shadow Garden, the sculpture by Steve Whitacre at the Jackson County Detention Center. The event will be held Thursday, November 5, 1998, from 5:15 to 6:15 p.m. and will take place in front of the Detention Center.

Katheryn Shields said that our Parks and Recreation staff continues to promote Jackson County's historical sites. Next Saturday, a crew is shooting video at Missouri Town 1855 for a documentary for a Civil War museum in Indianapolis. Katheryn commended the parks staff for their aggressive marketing of our historical sites.
