SUMMARY OF OUR REQUEST FOR LEGISLATIVE ACTION

Kansas City has a CURS agreement with Jackson County which provides for updating the project priorities list periodically. The current list was approved in July of 2006. Kansas City would like to change the priority list, mainly reordering the list.

One project (Botts Road) has been dropped from the list. The Kenneth Road Bridge project is shown as a priority but is only on the list to be funded if the costs overrun the funding established for it thru the Off System Bridge Program with MoDot (BRO funds) and the funds contributed by Overland Park.

The Public Works Department is in agreement with Kansas City on the new priority listing and recommends it be approved.

RESOLUTION NO. 091003

Recommending to Jackson County, Missouri certain roads and bridges to be improved under the provisions of the existing Jackson County Urban Road system agreement (CURS).

WHEREAS, Jackson County, Missouri, a constitutional home rule charter county, has entered into an agreement with Kansas City, Missouri dated June 1, 1976 for the allocation and expenditure of special road and bridge taxes on the portion of the County Urban Road System of Jackson County, Missouri, within Kansas City, Missouri; and
