5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Katheryn Shields, County Executive, introduced Bruce Palmer, the new Director of Facilities Management. She said he has worked for the City of Kansas City, Missouri for 25 years and has served as the Assistant City Architect since 1996. In that position, he supervised city staff in design, construction, operations, and maintenance. He was responsible for approximately 70 projects per year, at an average cost of \$2-3 million. Mr. Palmer has worked in the City;s Architectural Division since 1978, first as an Architect I, then Interim City Architect, and finally, Assistant City Architect. He has been responsible for architectural division management, an annual budget of 7 million, and a supervision of 65 staff.

Mr. Palmer's education includes a Bachelor of Architecture degree from Kansas State University. He is currently pursuing a Master's in Construction Management at the University of Kansas. He's been in the American Institute of Architects, Kansas City Chapter since 1982 and he is a member of the American Public Works Association.

He is also active in the community as a youth sports coach for basketball, soccer and baseball and has served as a board member of Kansas City Christian Schools from 1993-2002.

She introduced Art Chaudry who she hired as the Chief Administrative Officer (CAO). The County departments reporting to Art Chaundry will include Human Resources, Facilities Management, Economic Development and Management Information Systems. He brings 30 years of successful and distinguished management experience from the private sector, including, H & R Block, the Kansas City Royals Baseball Club, Aventis Pharmaceuticals, and Johnson and Johnson.

His education includes an M.B.A. in management from Loyola University of Chicago, and a B.S. in civil engineering from the University of Illinois, Champaign-Urbana.

Mr. Chaudry has also been active in community service, particularly in the promotion of diversity to build bridges across racial, ethnic, and religious barriers, winning the "Harmony Hero Award" while with the Kansas City Royals. He served as Chairman of the Board of Directors of the Urban League of Greater Kansas City, is a board member of the Crescent Peace Society of Kansas City and the American Muslim Council of the Heartland.
