Public Hearing regarding the property tax rates of Jackson County, Missouri, Board of Services for the Developmentally Disabled, the Community Mental Health Fund and the Merchants and Manufacturers' Inventory Replacement.

Scott Burnett opened the public hearing.

John Ivey, a taxpayer from Lee's Summit, Missouri, voiced his concerns on the levy/taxes in Jackson County, Missouri. He asked legislators to consider allowing taxpayers to pay commercial property taxes more than once a year. He also spoke about the M&M Replacement Tax and the issue of transportation.

Jake Jacobs from the Jackson County Board of Services for the Developmentally Disabled, thanked legislators for their continued support. He said although tax revenues are down by \$400,000.00 they are striving to maintain services.

Bruce Eddy with the Jackson County Community Mental Health Fund, said the levy is working hard as they have contracts with approximately 30 agencies. He stated that the requirements of the agencies are stringent and they are audited regularly.

Since no one else was present the speak, the public hearing was closed.
