AN ORDINANCE granting a conditional use permit (CUP) in District A (Agricultural) for a period of fifteen years to continue to operate a child day care center, subject to specified conditions, as to a .49 ± acre tract.

ORDINANCE #4329, August 1, 2011

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. A conditional use permit is hereby granted for a period of fifteen years to operate a childcare center, as to an approximate .49± acre tract of land generally located on the north side of Duncan Road approximately one-half mile east of R.D. Mize Road and specifically described as follows:

Description: The 0.49 ± acre tract is located on the north side of Duncan Road approximately ½ mile east of R.D. Mize Road and specifically described as part of the northeast quarter of Section 26, Township 49, Range 31, Jackson County, Missouri, described as follows: beginning at a point in the center line of R.D. Mize Road, said point being 1157 feet east of the west line of the northeast quarter of Section 26, thence north 270 feet; thence west 88 feet; thence south 270 feet to a point in the center of R.D. Mize Road; thence east 88 feet to the Point Of Beginning, except that part in R.D. Mize Road, aka 3255 NW Duncan Road.

<u>Section 2</u>. The conditional use permit granted by this Ordinance is subject to the following conditions:

- That applicant complies with all conditions contained within section 24005.6 of the Unified Development Code, relating to Child Day Care Centers.
- 2. That the applicant submit copies of all licenses upon renewal from the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services and any other agency as required by law to the Planning and Environmental Health Division.

- 3. That all driveways and parking areas located on subject tract be surfaced and paved.
- 4. The outdoor play area of the child day care center shall be enclosed with a fence, which shall have a minimum height of four feet.
- 5. The septic tank and propane tank shall be enclosed with a fence that has a minimum height of four feet and be inaccessible to children.

Section 3. The Legislature, pursuant to the application of Sally Jackson d/b/a Color Us Kids Family Childcare (CU-2011-208), requesting approval embodied in this Ordinance and with notice that the Jackson County Plan Commission voted 8 to 0 to recommend APPROVAL of this application in a public hearing on July 21, 2011, does adopt this Ordinance pursuant to the Jackson County Charter authorizing the Legislature to exercise legislative power pertaining to planning and zoning.

1. CU-2011-208 - Sally A. Jackson d/b/a Color Us Kids Family Childcare

Requesting a conditional use permit to continue operating a child day care center for a period of 25 years in District A (Agricultural) on 0.49 ± acres. The 0.49 ± acre tract is located on the north side of Duncan Road approximately ½ mile east of R.D. Mize Road lying in Section 26, Township 49, Range 31 in Jackson County, Missouri aka 3255 NW Duncan Road.

Mr. Trosen introduced CU-2011-208 and entered 14 exhibits into the record. Mr. Trosen gave the staff report with comments and recommendation as follows: the property is located approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ mile east of R.D. Mize Road on the north side of Duncan Road and is 0.49 \pm acres in size. The request is for a conditional use permit for a period of 25 years to continue operating a child day care center and the zoning is District A (Agricultural).

The property is currently being used for a child day care center. The applicant has been in operation for 10 years under a conditional use permit that was approved by the County Legislature in Ordinance 3154 on July 27, 2001. The surrounding area is predominantly residential tracts and zoned District A (Agricultural). There are eleven properties, two on the south side and nine on the north side of Duncan Road that are within the unincorporated area as a pocket surrounded by the Blue Springs city limits and Burr Oaks Conservation Area.

As previously mentioned, the applicant has been operating a child day care center on this property for 10 years. A conditional use permit was approved by the County Legislature on July 27, 2001 with Ordinance 3154. In reference to the site plan, the only significant change was an addition to the existing structure added for more space. The facility is currently licensed by the State of Missouri, Department of Health and Senior Services as a Group Child Care Home. The facility is licensed to care for a total of 18 boys and girls ages BIRTH through 17 years but is limited to 8 children in the infant/toddler unit. The facility is allowed to be open from 6:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. The current license expires November 30, 2011.

Staff contacted the state's regional office in Independence and spoke to a Licensing Specialist. The Licensing Specialist verified that the current license is valid and that the facility is currently in compliance with Missouri's licensing rules for Group Child Care Homes. In regards to the onsite wastewater disposal system, Steve Schnell, the county's On-site Wastewater Specialist, conducted an inspection of the facility's site. The septic tank and also a propane tank are within a fenced area which denies accidental access by children. Mr. Schnell evaluated the most probable absorption area and found no indication of any performance fatigue, stress or past failure. In his professional opinion, there is no visual evidence or reasonable performance doubt with the wastewater disposal system service that should interfere with allowing this land use to continue. The applicant has provided a receipt from Alton Sewer indicating that the system has recently been pumped and a minor repair made.

The applicant is requesting approval of the CUP for a period of 25 years. Although the applicant has been operating the facility under permit for 10 years with no complaints from surrounding property owners, Staff contends 25 years is too long and that this type of facility needs to be reviewed more frequently to ensure that it is compatible with surrounding land uses and in compliance with state and county regulations. Therefore, Staff will be recommending that the length of the permit should be effective for 15 years at which time it may be renewed in

accordance to established procedures. Staff recommends <u>APPROVAL</u> of CU-2011-208 for a period of fifteen (15) years subject to the following conditions:

- 1) That all conditions contained within Section 24005.6 of the Unified Development Code, relating to Child Day Care Centers be complied with.
- 2) That the applicant submit copies of all licenses upon renewal from the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services and any other agency as required by law to the Planning and Environmental Health Division.
- 3) That all driveways and parking areas located on subject tract be surfaced and paved.
- 4) The outdoor play area of the child day care center shall be enclosed with a fence, which shall have a minimum height of four (4) feet.
- 5) The septic tank and propane tank shall be enclosed with a fence that has a minimum height of four (4) feet and be inaccessible to children.

Mrs. Mershon wanted to know if yearly health inspections were required for the daycare center.

Mr. Trosen said that the licenses were issued for 3 years and a current copy of the license was kept on file at the county.

Mr. Haley wanted to know the ages of the children.

Mr. Trosen suggested that the applicant provide that information.

There were no further questions for Mr. Trosen.

The applicant, Sally Jackson, appeared to give testimony. Ms. Jackson said there were 5 children under 2; the youngest child was 6 months and the oldest, who had special needs, was 13.

Mrs. Mershon asked if the childcare center specialized in special needs children as the maximum age was 17.

Ms. Jackson said her license had been modified for this child so she could stay as she had been cared for since birth. She said previously the maximum age was 12.

Mr. Crawford wanted to know why the current license was only for 6 months if licenses were for 3 years.

Ms. Jackson said her current license had been modified but the expiration date had not changed. She said licenses are issued for 3 years; the fire marshal and health inspectors do annual inspections and the licensing officials do inspections twice a year to ensure compliance to regulations.

Ms. Querry asked how many care givers there were.

Ms. Jackson said there was a staff of 2 in addition to herself and there were 13 children. 10 children were in the pre-school side. The infant/toddler ratio was 1 to 4.

Mr. Haley asked about educational issues.

Ms. Jackson said she had a B.A. in early childhood education and blended 2 programs into the curriculum.

Mrs. Querry asked if the facility was considered a pre-school.

Ms. Jackson answered yes.

There were no further questions for the applicant and no one else to appear in favor of or in opposition to the application.

Mrs. Mershon moved to take CU-2011-208 under advisement. Mr. Scarborough seconded the motion.

Chairman Antey said he had no problem with the 15 year time limit.

Mr. Pointer wanted to know why length was being stretched from 10 year to 15 years.

Chairman Antey said a shorter time length is originally approved in order for applicant to develop a track record. In this instance there had been no complaints so he saw no problem with extending the permit to 15 years.

Mr. Haley agreed that 25 years was too long and 15 more reasonable.

Mr. Crawford asked if the commission could step out of advisement as he had another question for the applicant.

Voice vote approved suspending advisement.

Mr. Crawford asked the applicant if she was comfortable with the conditions, specifically the 15 vs. 25 year time limit.

Ms. Jackson said she had no problems with the conditions. She said the only reason she had asked for 25 years was she would be eligible for retirement then.

There were no further questions.

Mrs. Mershon moved to re-take CU-2011-208 under advisement. Mr. Crawford seconded the motion.

There was no further discussion. Mr. Pointer moved to approve CU-2011-208. Mr. Haley seconded the motion.







In preparation for the Conditional Use Permit renewal hearing, an inspection of the facility site was conducted this date to remedially evaluate the On-Site Wastewater Disposal System status.

Owner/Proprietor Sally Jackson was present during the walk through visual inspection. The septic tank location was identified within a fenced in section of the back yard that also houses the propane tank and denies accidental access to either utility by exploratory children. Although presently covered with stored containers within the fencing, the service riser of the septic tank is accessible and Mrs. Jackson states that routine pumping maintenance occurs every three years as recommended. By inspection request, she is currently locating the latest pumping receipt to provide us a copy prior to the scheduled hearing.

Due to the age of this system no accurate file records are available, but a walk through evaluation of the most probable absorption area produces zero indication of any performance fatigue, stress or past failure. MODHSS conducts annual inspections of this facility in accordance with the States Childcare permit requirements and wastewater disposal is assumed to be a priority concern during inspection. In summary, there is no visual evidence or reasonable performance doubt with the wastewater disposal system service that should interfere with extension of this zoning permit.
