#### 5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Mike Sanders, County Executive, said as of today Jackson County is done with formal layoffs.

Fred Siems, Chief Administrative Officer, gave a power point presentation titled Fiscal Year 2009 & 2010 Budget Update - Jackson County, Missouri - October 2009. (Copy available in County Clerk's office)

Mike Sanders said they have balanced the 2009 budget which had a 10 million dollar shortfall and are working on the 2010 budget which has a 12.1 million dollar shortfall.

He thanked Teresa York, Court Administrator and Steve Nixon, Presiding Judge for their cooperation while working on the 2010 budget.

Henry C. Rizzo, County Legislator, said the employees are an asset in Jackson County and he is impressed that there will be no more layoffs.

Dennis Waits, County Legislator, commented that the relationship with the courts did not just happen by accident. Mike Sanders took time to sit down with Judge Nixon and the communication has improved.

Henry C. Rizzo thanked Scott Burnett-Chairman, Mary Jo Spino-Clerk of the County Legislature and Gary Panethiere-Legislative Auditor, for their hard work on the budget and for making the difficult cuts necessary, including cuts to each of the legislators' budgets.
