WHEREAS, the appointment of these park rangers pursuant to state law is in the best interest of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of the County; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that Richard Wright and Sandi Macht be and hereby are appointed as park rangers pursuant to section 64.335, of the Revised Statutes of Missouri, with all rights and privileges granted by that section; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the County Legislature be and hereby is authorized to administer the required oath of office to the newly appointed park rangers.
