## COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT FOR ANIMAL SHELTER SERVICES

APR 1.2 2010

This is an Agreement between Wayside Waifs, Inc. hereinafter referred to as "The Shelter" by and through its President and Jackson County, Missouri, a constitutional home rule charter county of the first class of the state of Missouri, hereinafter referred to as "The County," by and through its County Executive.

Whereas, the Shelter desires both to provide animal shelter space for small domestic animals and to properly dispose of dead animals for the County and the County desires to use this service; and

Whereas, this Agreement sets forth the mutual responsibilities and obligations of the parties for provision and payment of the services described above; NOW THEREFORE,

## IT IS AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The term of this Agreement shall be for one year commencing on January 1, 2010 and may be renewed on an annual basis thereafter for up to three years after and not to exceed a 5% increase for each term.
- 2. The President of the Shelter or such officer at the time performing duties equivalent to that of the President of the Shelter, shall be the Administrative Officer for the Shelter respecting this Agreement, and any approvals or other decisions necessary under this Agreement will be made by the President. The Director of Public Works of Jackson County, or such officer at the time performing duties equivalent to that of Director of Public Works, shall be the Administrative Officer for the county respecting this Agreement and any approvals or other decisions necessary under this Agreement.
- 3. The Administrative Officers shall meet at least 90 days prior to the anniversary date of this agreement to determine the adequacy of cost for services. The Administrative Officers, upon mutual agreement, may increase the costs to assure agreement adequacy, however, no increase shall exceed 5% in any one year without the Jackson County Legislature approval.
- 4. The Shelter agrees to provide shelter space for small animals picked up by the animal control agency of the County for a cost of \$100 per animal for the 5 day holding period required by the state of Missouri. These dogs and cats will be disposed of pursuant to the County's ordinances. All adoption fees, boarding fees and other applicable fees collected at the Shelter shall be retained by the Shelter.
- 5. Staff of the Shelter shall provide care to these small animals.
- 6. The Shelter shall receive live animals from the County during normal business hours.

- 7. Administrative staff of the Shelter shall keep records, process redemptions and adoptions, and handle all paperwork for each small animal.
- 8. The enforcement agency of the County shall be responsible for notifying residents of said County of where their animals will be taken. Residents of the County will be able to redeem their animal, or adopt an animal from the shelter during normal business hours. Any applicable redemption fines or fee will be collected by the Shelter before an animal is released to its owner by staff of the Shelter. Proper paperwork from the Shelter will be required before such release is granted. If proof is not sufficient, staff of the Shelter shall refuse such redemption until adequate proof is produced, or until requested by an agent for the County.
- 9. The Shelter will receive dead animals during business hours from the County at a cost of \$15 per dog or cat, and small wild animals such as squirrels and opossums.
- 10. The shelter will bill the County monthly for live and dead animals delivered to the Shelter. The County will ensure that payment is received by the Shelter within thirty (30) days after the bill is mailed.
- 11. This Agreement may be terminated by any of the parties upon thirty (30) days written notice. Payment shall be made under the terms of this Agreement for any services already provided, rendered or committed as of the date of such termination.
- 12. No party to this Agreement shall assume any liability for the acts of any other party to this contract, its officers or employees.
