Barb, after examination of the two bids received, I advise that we renew with Travelers on 10-1-10 with a quoted annual premium of \$341,500. They will allow us to make 2 installment payments (\$170,750 on 10-1-10 and the second installment of \$170,750 on April 1,2011). Last year our annual premium was \$511,475, so we are enjoying a substantial decrease.

Arrowhead stadium is still on a Builders Risk policy written by Thomas McGee L.C. in the amount of \$225,000,000. Travelers will add this amount to our policy when we are notified. The additional amount is at the same rate/\$100 of value, so the annual premium for the additional will be \$81,000 annually. This amount will be pro-rata from the date it is added.
