SUMMARY	In 2009, the County and City of Kansas City, Missouri e	entered into an agreement t	o provide housing and related			
	In 2009, the County and City of Kansas City, Missouri entered into an agreement to provide housing and related services to the City for their municipal inmates. This partnership has been an excellent approach to providing					
	governmental jailing services in a more efficient manner.

	For several years, there were discussions to consolidate	the 8th floor jail housed at t	the Kansas City Police			
	Department Headquarters at the County's Department of Corrections (DOC). After many discussions, an approach has been agreed upon that will provide for a full regional system. In highlight, persons arrested in					
	Kansas City will be taken to a district station by the Kansas City Police Department on both state and city					
	charges. In the event the individual will not be able to bond out or be released, the detainee will be transported					
	to the County DOC to be held for arraignment at the next available date (Monday – Saturday). After					
	arraignment, if the judge determines the individual is to be held, the individual will become an immate of either					
	the County's operation at DOC on state charges or the R	egional Correctional Center	er (RCC) on the municipal			

		charges. Arraignment will be done by video for city charges, so the individual does not have to be transported to another facility for court. Additionally, the KCPD will intake the individual's property at the district station which will simply be housed at DOC rather than duplicating the intake process.					
		Housing the detainees of KCPD and the inmates of DOC or RCC within the same facility provides for an extraordinary opportunity to improve governmental efficiencies. Based on the negotiated agreement, the City is funding capital improvements necessary to provide additional space for this consolidation up to \$1,067,000. Once constructed, KCPD will have a maximum of 100 beds; and the City is expanding its beds to a total of 175 (150 male beds and 25 beds). A cost of \$52.50 per inmate per bed will be charged to the City to fund the cost of operations including staffing, security, food, health care, and related services. The County is able to lower this cost per inmate per day to the City by approximately \$10 per day due to the overall efficiencies gains in the new approach. The proposed agreement is a 10 year agreement. The County provides access to mental health services, healthcare, drug and alcohol treatment, GED education, and other social services as a part of the operation. This is an excellent example of regional partnership and completes what was implemented in 2009 with the City.
