May 31 - Bicycle races, festival at Truman Sports Complex


Added and Updated Features for 2015

NEW 5K run – hundreds of community members will participate in a run on Cliff Drive; Jackson County-subsidized entry fees can apply to runners, bike ride participants, and race participants

Profile of Women's Races raised – Winners purse for Women's Bicycle Races (all days) will be raised to a higher amount than men's races. This is the first event in the U.S. to take this step as far as we know. We believe this will very substantially raise the profile and participation numbers in the women's race events and make TKC one of the premier women's bicycle races in the region and country.

Profile of Youth Races Raised – we are working to raise the profile and participation rates of the Youth Races by making them part of national youth racing series. We believe we can dramatically raise the profile and participation rates of youth bicycle racing events this year, making the event a regional and national leaders in the youth development racing scene. Jackson County's funding can (among other things) help subsidized entry fees to cover participation and entry fees for promising youth racers from the County who may not otherwise be able to participate.
