Mike Sanders, County Executive, said this is an exciting time to be a sports fan in Jackson County and Kansas City. The Royals are still in first place by half of a game, the best record they have had at this time of year since 1982. The Chiefs home opener is this Sunday against the Tennessee Titans

Mike Sanders announced that on September 3 at 3:00 P.M. Jackson County will kick off the Chiefs season and honor a great public servant on the County Legislature, Fred Arbanas, for his 42 years of service to Jackson County. Fred Arbanas was drafted in 1961 and played for the Chiefs until 1973. He is a member of the Chiefs Hall of Fame, a 6 time AFL All Star and a 3 time AFL Champion. They will be selling Chiefs Kingdom flags for \$4.00 each and all proceeds will to to the Ronald McDonald House in Kansas City, Missouri.
