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5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Mike Sanders, County Executive, said Jackson County's TIF Policy will be presented to the County Legislature at the legislative meeting scheduled to be held on May 19, 2008.

He said the Missouri House and Senate passed funding in the amount of half million dollars for renovation of the Historic Independence Courthouse on the Square and it is awaiting the Governor's signature.

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James D. Tindall, County Legislator, asked if it was true that a State Representative from Independence opposed legislation for funding the renovation.

Mike Sanders, County Executive, said it was true.

The Building Trades Memorandum of Understanding is on the agenda. He asked County Legislators to contact the Administration with any questions as they would like to adopt this legislation next week.

The judicial panel will submit the 3 names to the County Executive by June 9th.

There will be a closed session scheduled for May 19, 2008 regarding the adult entertainment industry.

Henry C. Rizzo, County Legislator, asked the Administration and County Counselor to check into doing what Johnson County did as far as putting current outstanding warrants on the Internet. This procedure has cleared many warrants in a short period of time.

Mike Sanders agreed to review it and report back to the County Legislature.
