REQUEST SUMMARY	This resolution authorizes the County Executive to execute 27 contracts with the following agencies to address food insecurity brought on by the COVID-19 pandemic and subsequent economic recession (see attached list) using CARES Act funding received by Jackson County in 2020. Round one of CARES Act funding provided \$500,000 to Harvesters – Community Food Network of Kansas via Ordinance #5371. Round two of food assistance provided up to \$800,000 for this continuing effort including \$100,000 to Community Services League, \$70,000 to One Good Meal (Ordinance #5420) and \$543,700 to 16 different agencies. A total of \$1,800,000 has been allocated for this effort with \$1,713,800 under contract or expended. A total of \$700,690 was requested in this third round of funding from 29 agencies with the maximum allowable request of \$30,000 per agency. Two agencies requested funding, but the amount of their request was less than the funding for Round Two that remained unspent as of March 15, 2021 and are not recommended for additional funding in this round. For the current round of funding, agencies that requested \$30,000 in Round 3 and did not receive any funding in Round 2 were each allocated up to \$23,000 in Round 3. Agencies that received the full allocation in Round 2 were allocated a maximum of \$20,000 less any funds remaining unspent from Round 2. All agencies are allowed up to 10% for administrative costs. The proposed allocations are attached separately to this RLA.
