REQUEST SUMMARY	In late 2012, the County authorized a contract with Motorola, Inc to upgrade the public safety radio system. To date, the system has been designed and subscriber equipment has been purchased and programmed. In order to provide adequate radio coverage in the eastern portion of the County, the County intends to enter into an agreement with the City of Oak Grove to allow the County to place antenna equipment on a City-owned water tower. This license agreement will provide space for equipment that will add coverage to the digital radio system. The City will benefit from increased radio coverage for their public safety personnel and the only cost to the County will be utility cost related to the radio equipment, which will be paid directly to the utility company.					
	On October 21, 2013, Jackson County entered into an agreement with the City of Kansas City, Missouri to join the Metropolitan Area Regional Radio System (MARRS). As a member of MARRS, the County is required to comply with standards adopted by the MARRS board in order to maintain the integrity of the P25 Digital Radio					

		System. Because the County is adding two new sites to the regional system, agencies that fall within the geographic boundaries of the coverage sites added by the County must agree to comply with the MARRS requirements as well. One such site is the City of Oak Grove, who is providing space on a city-owned water tower for the County's radio equipment.
