BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County Executive be, and is hereby, authorized to execute for the County an Addendum to the Professional Services Agreement with Glen Newton of Sugar Creek, MO, in a form to be approved by the County Counselor.

FIRST ADDENDUM
PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT

THIS FIRST ADDENDUM, made as of the 10 day of March,
2010, by and between JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI, (hereinafter referred to as "the
County") and GLEN NEWTON, 11411 Norledge, Sugar Creek, MO 64054 (hereinafter
referred to as "Investigator"),

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the County and Investigator did enter into a professional services
agreement dated January 4, 2010, whereunder Investigator agreed to provide temporary
investigative services for the Independence Prosecutor's Office, at a cost to the County not
to exceed \$6,394.00; and,

WHEREAS, the parties now desire to extend the agreement for the period of
February 16, 2010 through March 26, 2010 at no additional cost to the County; and,

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and the terms and provisions
herein contained, the County and Investigator respectively promise, covenant and agree
as follows:

1. Except as expressly provided herein, all provisions of the professional
services agreement between the parties dated January 4, 2010, shall remain
in full force and effect.
2. This First Addendum to the Agreement shall be effective February 16, 2010
and extend through March 26, 2010.


