A RESOLUTION partially rescinding Resolution 17279, dated May 20, 2010, and awarding the remainder of a twelve-month term and supply contract for the furnishing of professional mortuary (cremation) services to Slider Funeral Home of Kansas City, KS, under the terms and conditions of Request for Proposals No. 6-09.

RESOLUTION #17465, January 4, 2011

INTRODUCED BY Scott Burnett, County Legislator

WHEREAS, by Resolution 17279, dated May 20, 2010, the Legislature did award twelve-month term and supply contracts for the furnishing of professional mortuary services to Marts Memorial Services of Kansas City (Jackson County), MO, to provide cremation services and Slider Funeral Home of Kansas City, KS, to provide burial services for individuals who die within the County and have no means of paying a funeral expense; and,

WHEREAS, the Missouri Board of Embalmers and Funeral Directors has revoked the license for Marts Memorial Services effective December 31, 2010; and,

WHEREAS, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends the re-award of the cremation services contract to Slider Funeral Home of Kansas City, KS, as the second lowest cost proposal for cremation services received under RFP No. 6-09; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the portion of Resolution 17279, dated May 20, 2010, awarding a contract for the furnishing of

cremation services to Marts Memorial Services of Kansas City, MO, is hereby rescinded;
and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that award be made as recommended by the Director of Finance and Purchasing and that the Director be, and is hereby, authorized to execute for the County any documents necessary for the accomplishment of the award; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the contract, to the extent that sufficient appropriations to the using spending agency have been made in the then current Jackson County budget.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.

<p>REQUEST SUMMARY</p>	<p>On June 28, 2010, Resolution No. 17279 was passed awarding a Twelve Month Term and Supply Contract for the furnishing of Professional Mortuary Services to Marts Memorial Services of Kansas City, Missouri and Slider Funeral Home of Kansas City, Kansas. The Missouri Board of Embalmers and Funeral Directors has revoked the license for Marts Memorial Services; the business must close by December 31, 2010. Marts Memorial Services was awarded the Cremation Services portion of the Contract and Slider Funeral Home was awarded the Burial Services portion of the Contract for decedents who die in Jackson County, Missouri and without sufficient means available to provide for the expense of cremation or burial. Slider Funeral Home was the second low bid on Cremation Services.</p> <p>Pursuant to Section 1054.6 of the Jackson County Code, 1984, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends the re-award of the Cremation Services portion of this contract to Slider Funeral Home of Kansas City, Kansas as the second lowest proposal received under Request for Proposal No. 6-09.</p> <p>This award is made on an "as needed" basis.</p>
