A RESOLUTION authorizing the County Executive and the Prosecuting Attorney to execute an Agreement to Extend the Memorandum of Understanding with Local Union No. 42 of the International Association of Fire Fighters, through October 1, 2013.

RESOLUTION NO. 18202, June 24, 2013

INTRODUCED BY Dennis Waits, Theresa Garza Ruiz, Dan Tarwater, and Crystal Williams, County Legislators

WHEREAS, by Resolution 17258, dated April 19, 2010, the Legislature did authorize the execution of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Local Union No. 42 of the International Association of Fire Fighters to govern the terms and conditions of employment of members of its bargaining unit within the Prosecuting Attorney's Office through December 31, 2012; and,

WHEREAS, by Resolution 18027, dated November 19, 2012, that agreement was extended through June 30, 2013; and,


WHEREAS, the parties have undertaken negotiations on a successor MOU, but have not yet reached agreement; and,


WHEREAS, in view of the pending negotiations, and in anticipation of arriving at a successor MOU, the Legislature has determined that it is appropriate to extend the terms of the prior MOU, through October 1, 2013; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the County Executive and the Prosecuting Attorney be and hereby is authorized to execute an Agreement to Extend MOU with Local Union No. 42 of the International Association of Fire Fighters, for a period ending October 1, 2013, in a form to be approved by the County Counselor.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.


