WHEREAS, the purpose of the Recovery Walk is to raise community awareness of the disease of addiction; and,


WHEREAS, COMBAT will serve as an organizational partner for the event and will benefit by the advertising and community awareness this sponsorship will promote; and,



<p>REQUEST SUMMARY</p>	<p>A resolution authorizing the County Executive for the payment of sponsoring the Michael Johnson Walk for Recovery, to be funded by the County's Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund, which are engaged in anti-drug treatment activities and purposes, at a cost to the County not to exceed \$1,000.00.</p> <p><b>Background:</b> The Anti-Drug Sales Tax fund authorizes the County to execute agreements and contracted service for the purpose of providing substance abuse treatment, prevention, grant match, and other anti-drug initiatives in the community.</p> <p>The Kansas City area will be hosting the 2nd Annual Recovery Month event to raise community awareness of the disease of addiction. On September 10, 2011 the Mike Johnson Memorial Walk for Recovery celebrates the Department of Health and Human Services, Substance Abuse &amp; Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA)'s National Recovery Month. The goal is to spread the word that addiction is treatable, recovery is possible and communities can heal. Recovery Month provides a platform to celebrate people in recovery and those who serve them. Each September, thousands of recovering people around the country celebrate their successes and share them with their neighbors, friends, and colleagues in an effort to educate the public about treatment and recovery, how it works, for whom, and why. Recovery Month also serves to educate the public on substance abuse as a national health crisis, that addiction is a treatable disease, and that recovery is possible. Recovery Month highlights the benefits of treatment for not only the affected individual, but for their family, friends, workplace, and society as a whole. Educating the public reduces the stigma associated with addiction and treatment. Accurate knowledge of the disease helps people to understand the importance of supporting treatment programs, those who work within the treatment field, and those in need of treatment.</p>
