Postage Account – Request for Legislative Action

Shelly, as we discussed, we are running extremely low on postage money. When going through the budget process last fall we informed the County that we would be required, as we are every even-numbered year to mail voter ID cards to all active registered voters informing them of their new precincts. This is a statutory requirement of election law Chapter 115.163 RSMo.

Since the Board has completed redistricting and has had to re-number the precincts and change many districts of most all active registered voters, these voters must receive a new voter ID card. The total cost of the mailing will be approximately \$48,300.00. Currently we have \$27,600.51 in our postage budget with the County. We have approximately \$8000.00 in our account at the post office. This leaves us almost \$13,000.00 short on this mailing with no postage money to get through the August and November elections.

When talking with you, Bob and I thought we would need \$20,000.00 to get through the year, but in reality, I think we will need \$25,000.00. In the next two weeks we will begin mailing the military and overseas ballots which depletes our postage quickly.
