Introduction
<b>Action Items:</b> ['Authorize']
<b>Project/Title:</b>
An Ordinance imposing a countywide sales tax of three percent on all tangible personal property retail sales of adult use, non-medicinal marijuana.

Request Summary
<p>Article XIV, section 2.6(5) of the Missouri Constitution authorizes the governing body of a county to impose a countywide sales tax on all tangible personal property retail sales of adult use non-medicinal marijuana sold in such county.</p> <p>Article XIV, section 2.6(5) provides that the tax authorized by this section shall be in addition to any and all other sales taxes allowed by law, except that no ordinance or order imposing a sales tax shall be effective unless the governing body of the county submits to the voters of the county, at a county or state general, primary, or special election, a proposal to authorize the governing body of the county to impose the tax.</p> <p>By Ordinance 5710, dated January 24, 2023, the County authorized a ballot question on the April 4, 2023, election submitting to the qualified voters of Jackson County, Missouri, at a special election to be held on April 4, 2023, a question authorizing Jackson County to impose a countywide sales tax of three percent on all tangible personal property retail sales of adult use, non-medicinal marijuana.</p> <p>At the special election held on April 4, 2023, by a vote of 65% to 35%, the voters of Jackson County did approve this countywide sales tax. It is now appropriate that the County should approve an ordinance imposing the sales tax and authorizing the Missouri Department of Revenue to begin collecting such revenues.</p>
