Greg Grounds moved to recommend for perfection Ordinance #3966, transferring \$16,457.00 within and appropriating \$164,581.00 from the unappropriated surplus of the 2008 Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund in acceptance of a grant from the Missouri Department of Public Safety, and authorizing the County Executive to execute Cooperative Agreements with Arts Tech and Deana Bellamaganya for the Prosecuting Attorney's Office's Sentenced to the Arts program, at an aggregate cost to the County not to exceed \$164,581.00. Seconded by Theresa Garza Ruiz.

Greg Grounds moved to hold Resolution #16492, authorizing the County Executive to execute agreements with certain outside agencies funded by the County's Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund for the 2008 fiscal year, which are engaged in anti-drug treatment activities and purposes, at an aggregate cost to the County not to exceed \$2,965,378.00. Seconded by Theresa Garza Ruiz.
