AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$1,400.00 from the unappropriated surplus of the 2008 Grant Fund to cover a grant received from the Missouri Highway and Transportation Commission for Missouri's Blueprint for Roadway Safety: Aggressive Driving Enforcement Campaign, and authorizing the County Executive to execute an Agreement for the participation of the Sheriff's office in the May 2008, DWI Enforcement Wave.

ORDINANCE #3986, April 21, 2008

WHEREAS, the Missouri Highway and Transportation Commission has awarded the Sheriff's Office a grant in the amount of \$1,400.00 to be used for the overtime Costs for the office's participation in the Commission's Missouri's Blueprint for Roadway Safety: Aggressive Driving Enforcement Campaign; and,

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office has requested the County Executive be authorized to execute an Agreement for its participation; and,

WHEREAS, the grant requires no local matching funds, and the term is May 2, 2008, to May 5, 2008; and,

WHEREAS, an appropriation is necessary to place the grant funds in the appropriate spending account; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the

Contract for May 2-5, 2008 DWI Enforcement Wave

This contract is between **Jackson County Sheriffs Department** and the Missouri Safety Center for the time period of **May 2-5, 2008**, to conduct overtime enforcement activities in DWI Enforcement. The above named agency shall be defined as a sub-contractor to the Missouri Safety Center for this identified activity. This enforcement will include Saturation Patrols, Special DWI Operations, Wolf Packs and Sobriety Checkpoints.*

Agreements & Duties:

The **Jackson County Sheriffs Department** agrees to provide staffing for the overtime enforcement for a period of 4 days, for a total claim not to exceed **\$1400.00**, which is the total funding provided for the enforcement period. The enforcement agency agrees to submit activity and manpower reports to the Missouri Safety Center no later than 23 days following the enforcement, and to **fax enforcement activity and Manpower Reports on or before May 2-5, 2008 prior to 9:00 AM**. Prompt submission of the manpower report will allow the reimbursement check to be processed in a timely manner and sent to the agency for payment/recovery of paid salaries for officers doing overtime enforcement. The enforcement agency agrees to submit as part of the request for reimbursement the summary sheet outlining which officers worked the enforcement program and their overtime rate and benefits paid as well as a summary sheet showing the numbers of violations sited during the effort. **The enforcement agency also agrees to provide only P.O.S.T. Certified law enforcement officers that are SFST Certified, for this overtime enforcement activity.** (Note: this now allows part time officers to participate in the enforcement program). In addition, the enforcement agency agrees to provide to local media a pre & post press release (samples in packet) to notify the public of their DWI enforcement efforts. All enforcement will be tied to Missouri's current campaign, called **"You Drink & Drive. You Lose!"**

The Missouri Safety Center agrees to provide the reimbursement to the agency up to the allocated amount of funding provided for the enforcement period and to analyze and tally all participating agencies data into a statewide report to be submitted to Missouri Department of Transportation - Highway Safety Division. Further, this data will be used to assess the statewide plan for addressing DWI problems in Missouri.

Specifically, we are asking your agency to conduct this special enforcement operation during May 2-5, 2008. This special DWI enforcement is a statewide effort to increase observed enforcement in areas where DWI Crashes are occurring.

As part of the effort to reduce DWI related crashes, the agency may make use of any electronic message boards and speed trailers. We request that any electronic display read as follows: **You Drink & Drive. You Lose.**

Notices: Right of Termination, If through any clause, the enforcement agency shall fail to fulfill in a timely and proper manner its obligations under this contract,

or if the enforcement agency violates any of the agreements, or stipulations of this contact, the Missouri Safety Center shall have the right to terminate this contact and withhold further payment of any kind by giving written notice to the enforcement agency. The Missouri Safety Center and University of Central Missouri shall be the sole arbitrator of whether the enforcement agency is performing its obligations in a proper manner with reference to the quality performed by the terms of the contract. Either party may terminate this contract by giving written notice of such termination and specifying the effective date of the action. **All parties must comply with the provisions of 41 CFR Chapter 60 as defined by the U.S. Department of Labor.**

We the undersigned agree to the terms of the contract, and agree to participate in this statewide enforcement effort to keep our roadways safe for the citizens who travel them.
