WHEREAS, nearly 1.5 million students throughout the United States entered the 2014 Merit Program as juniors by taking the preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test, which serves as an initial screen of program entrants; and,

WHEREAS, Kyle's parents, Jenny and Jim Angle, are justifiably proud of their son; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the Legislature hereby congratulates Kyle Angle upon his recognition as a National Merit Scholarship Finalist and a Missouri Scholars 100 student, and extends best wishes to him in all of his future endeavors.
