**IN THE COUNTY LEGISLATURE OF JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI**

**AN ORDINANCE** appropriating \$2,000,000.00 from the undesignated fund balance of the 2020 CARES Act Fund to provide funds to Children's Mercy Hospital to maximize COVID-19 testing for children in Jackson County and authorizing the County Executive to execute a cooperative agreement with Children's Mercy Hospital, at a cost to the County not exceed \$2,000,000.00.

**ORDINANCE NO. 5417**, October 5, 2020

**INTRODUCED BY** Theresa Cass Galvin, County Legislator

WHEREAS, U.S. President Donald J. Trump, Missouri Governor Mike Parson, and County Executive Frank White, Jr., have all declared, in one form or another, the ongoing Coronavirus/COVID-19 pandemic to be a public health emergency; and,

WHEREAS, the County, through its various efforts, plays a significant role in the public health of its citizens; and,

WHEREAS, an appropriate response by the County to this emergency will require significant expenditures from the County CARES Act Fund, which consists of monies provided by the U.S. Treasury for this purpose; and,

WHEREAS, with the funding provided by this appropriation Children's Mercy Hospital (CMH) will increase its capacity to perform drive-thru COVID-19 testing in Jackson County, provide community pediatricians with testing supplies and courier services to transfer tests to CMH for analysis, and collaborate with local school districts for on-site testing; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the following appropriation be and hereby is made:

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Director of Finance and Purchasing be and hereby is authorized to make all payments, including final payment on the agreement.


