5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Katheryn Shields, County Executive, presented a ten year service pin to Bob Crutsinger, Assistant Director of the Accounting Department.

Katheryn Shields announced that Christmas in the Park opened on Wednesday, November 27, 1996. There will be television, radio and newspaper coverage on this holiday event.

Katheryn Shields reported that the Corrections Department and the AFSCME Local 1707 (AFL-CIO) hosted a Thanksgiving dinner at the Cleveland Avenue Baptist Church. They had 40 volunteers who helped serve the dinner and deliver food to area shut-ins. More than 135 meals were served or delivered. The City of Kansas City also had volunteers helping with this event. She thanked the Corrections Department for their efforts.

Katheryn Shields said that William O. Lona, her appointment to the Jackson County Housing Resources Commission, will attend the legislative meeting on December 9, 1996.

Katheryn Shields submitted the 1997 recommended budget. Since the County will not have any elections next year there is a savings of one million dollars which has been allocated to fund a 2% across the board salary increase for all County employees. In addition to that the County has set up a new fund called the Public Building Corporation Capital Projects Fund. The purpose of this fund is two fold. Ten million dollars will be given to Truman Medical Center West to update and improve their facilities. One million dollars worth of bonds will be sold to construct a new medical examiner's office on hospital hill. The budget also includes the purchase of additional vehicles for Public Works and the Sheriff's Department to reduce maintenance costs. It also includes funding for a change in the pension fund.
