AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$32,085.46 from the fund balance of the 2010 Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund to fund a contractual interest payment and employee salaries and benefits for the Jackson County Drug Court program.

ORDINANCE #4199, March 29, 2010

INTRODUCED BY Dan Tarwater, County Legislator

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 3791, dated July 24, 2006, the Legislature did authorize the County Executive to execute an Interlocal Agreement as a component of the 2006 Byrne Justice Assistance Grant awarded by the U.S. Department of Justice; and,

WHEREAS, section 5 of the Interlocal Agreement requires the County to establish a trust fund account and further requires the County to provide the City of Kansas City with half of the interest earned on the trust fund account at the close of the grant period; and,

WHEREAS, section 4 of the Interlocal Agreement authorizes funding for the Jackson County Drug Court program; and,

WHEREAS, the County's portion of the interest from the trust fund account is to be used to fund employee salaries and benefits for the Jackson County Drug Court program; and,

WHEREAS, an appropriation is necessary in order to place the funds in the proper

spending accounts; and,

WHEREAS, the County Executive recommends said appropriation; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the following appropriation be and is hereby made:

BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF JACKSON, MISSOURI AND
THE CITY OF GRANDVIEW, MISSOURI
THE CITY OF INDEPENDENCE, MISSOURI
THE CITY OF KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI**

2006 BYRNE JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM AWARD

This Agreement is made and entered into this _____ day of March, 2006, by and between The COUNTY of Jackson, acting through the Prosecutor's Office, Jackson County, Missouri (County), the CITY of Grandview (CITY1), the CITY of Independence (CITY2), and the CITY of Kansas City (CITY3).

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs has collectively allotted \$569,958 to the above-named units of government for state and local law enforcement-related initiatives, and

WHEREAS, each governing body agrees that Jackson County shall serve as the fiscal agent for the funds, and

WHEREAS, each governing body finds that the performance of this Agreement is in the best interests of all parties, that the undertaking will benefit the public, and that the division of costs fairly compensates the performing party for the services of functions under this agreement; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY agrees to provide to CITY1 \$17,099 from the JAG award to Purchase Law Enforcement Equipment: and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY agrees to provide to CITY2 \$62,695 from the JAG award to Purchase Law Enforcement Related Equipment: and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY agrees to provide to CITY3 \$302,078 from the JAG award. The City of Kansas City agrees to provide \$152,078 of said award to the Board of Police Commissioners, Kansas City, for Crime Laboratory Upgrade/Expansion Program. The

remaining \$150,000 will be used by the City of Kansas City for crime prevention efforts through the KC Safe Program and the Center for Community Solutions as well as for Illegal Dumping prevention efforts: and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY and CITY1, CITY2, CITY3 believe it to be in their best interests to reallocate the JAG funds.

NOW THEREFORE, the COUNTY and CITY1, CITY2, CITY3 agree as follows:

Section 1.

COUNTY agrees to pay CITY1 a total of \$17,099 of JAG funds.

CITY1 agrees to use \$17,099 to Purchase Law Enforcement Related Equipment.

Section 2.

COUNTY agrees to pay CITY2 a total of \$62,695 of JAG funds.

CITY2 agrees to use \$62,695 to Purchase Law Enforcement Related Equipment.

Section 3.

COUNTY agrees to pay CITY3 a total of \$302,078 of JAG funds.

CITY3 agrees to pay Board of Police Commissioners, Kansas City, Missouri, \$152,078 for Crime Laboratory Upgrade/Expansion Program. The remaining \$150,000 will be used by the City of Kansas City for crime prevention efforts through the KC Safe Program and the Center for Community Solutions as well as for Illegal Dumping prevention efforts: and

Section 4.

COUNTY agrees to receive \$188,086 of JAG funds. County will spend \$50,000 to purchase computers and computer-related hardware and software. The remaining \$138,086 will be spent on wages and benefits for the Jackson County Drug Court Program.

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Section 5.

In accordance with the JAG legislation, COUNTY will establish a trust fund for the JAG funds. Interest accrued from the trust fund will be split equally between COUNTY and CITY3 at the end of each calendar year of the grant period and/or at the close of the grant period.

Section 6.

Nothing in the performance of this Agreement shall impose any liability for claims against COUNTY.

Section 7.

Nothing in the performance of this Agreement shall impose any liability for claims against any CITY.

Section 8.

Each party to this agreement shall be responsible for its own actions in providing services under this agreement and shall not be liable for any civil liability that may arise from the furnishing of the services by one or more of the other parties.

Section 9.

The parties to this Agreement do not intend for any third party to obtain a right by virtue of this agreement.

Section 10.


