

ADDENDUM TO AGREEMENT
(Extension to 2014 COMBAT Prevention)

THIS ADDENDUM TO AGREEMENT, by and between **JACKSON COUNTY, MISSOURI**, hereinafter referred to as "the County," and **GUADALUPE CENTERS, INC., 1015 AVENIDA CESAR E. CHAVEZ, KANSAS CITY, MO 64108**, a Missouri not-for-profit corporation, hereinafter referred to as "**Organization**," is made and entered into this 20th day of March, 2015.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, by Resolution 18402, dated February 10, 2014, the County and Organization did enter into an agreement whereby Organization agreed to provide anti-drug and/or anti-violent crime prevention activities and programs, at a cost to the County of \$54,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, the Jackson County Drug Commission has recommended an extension to the 2014 agreement for these services, at no additional cost to the County; and,

WHEREAS, by Resolution 18746, dated March 2, 2015, the County Legislature has authorized the County Executive to enter into this Addendum to Agreement;

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and promises herein contained, County and Organization do hereby additionally agree as follow:

1. Except as hereinafter specifically modified, all of the terms of the prior Agreement between the parties dated March 18, 2014, shall remain in full force and effect and the terms and conditions thereof are incorporated herein by reference.

2. This Addendum to Agreement shall be effective as of January 1, 2015,
