WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Legislature to work with the County Administration, County Counselor, and Taxing Jurisdictions in response to the concerns with the 2023 property tax assessment cycle process; and,


WHEREAS, the Legislature request that the Jackson County Department of Assessment identify property owners that have (1) not submitted an appeal for the 2023 assessment cycle or (2) have not accepted a settlement from the Board of Equalization or STC and who believe their property assessment is inaccurate; now therefore,

**BE IT RESOLVED** that the Jackson County Legislature hereby requests of the County Assessor via the County Executive to reopen the appeal submission for a period of 60 days to allow property owners to address potential wrong assessments; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** the Legislature requests the Jackson County Executive work in collaboration with Legislature toward providing fair and equitable assessments.

Effective Date: This Resolution shall be effective immediately upon its passage by a majority of the Legislature.
