WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office has requested the creation of a new non-merit position entitled Special Projects Coordinator to focus on training and recruitment; and,

WHEREAS, funding for this position was included in the annual budget; and,

WHEREAS, at its meeting of June 19, 2013, the Merit System Commission recommends this position be exempted from the provisions of the Merit System as provided in Article IX, Section 2 of the 2010 Jackson County Charter; and,

WHEREAS, the creation of this new non-merit staff position in the Sheriff's Office is in the best interests of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of Jackson County; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, as follows:

Section A. <u>Enacting Clause</u>. Schedule VI to Chapter 2, <u>Jackson County</u>, 1984, is hereby repealed, and one new schedule enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as Schedule VI, to read as follows:
