### 5 COMMUNICATIONS AND REPORTS OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Katheryn Shields, County Executive, announced that all Jackson County campgrounds will be open this weekend. The total number of campsites at all three campgrounds is 236 and reservations are encouraged.

This Friday and Saturday, May 14 and 15 from 9 am - 4:30 pm there will be a Flint Knap-In at Fort Osage. Skilled artists will practice the craft of knapping, an art of fashioning arrowheads and tools from flint. Admission is \$3 for adults, \$2 for youths and seniors, and children under 5 are free.
