WHEREAS, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, by document no. DACW41-2-84-14, previously granted the County an easement for the installation, operation, and maintenance of a communications tower within the boundaries of the lease area, which expired on August 16, 2009; and,

WHEREAS, the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers recommends the execution of the attached Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to Lease No. DACW41-1-89-181 for the purpose of adding the communications tower to the existing lease agreement; and,

WHEREAS, the communications tower contains antennas and equipment utilized by the Park Safety and Enforcement Division of the Parks and Recreation Department, the Public Works Department, and the Missouri Water Patrol; and,

WHEREAS, the execution of the attached Supplemental Agreement to Lease No. DACW41-1-89-181 is in the best interest of the health, welfare, and safety of the citizens of Jackson County; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the attached Supplemental Agreement to Lease No. DACW41-1-89-181 is hereby approved and that the County Executive is hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the County the Agreement and any other documents necessary to give effect to this Resolution.

Re: RLA – COE Agreement pertaining to existing communication tower

The purpose of the RLA is to authorize the County Executive to execute a COE (Corps of Engineers) supplemental agreement to the overall lease agreement for Blue Springs Lake which will add the existing communications tower.

The COE has requested that the County execute the Supplemental Agreement because the easement No. DACW41-2-84-14 granted to the County for the installation, operation and maintenance of a communications tower expired on August 16, 2009.

The tower is generally located north of Woods Chapel Road across from Rennau Drive in the area commonly referred to as the Fleming Youth Camp. I have attached a location map to the RLA.

The communications tower contains antennas and equipment utilized by Parks & Recreation – Park Safety and Enforcement Division, Public Works Maintenance and Missouri Water Patrol.

Although we may not have a use for the tower once the County's new radio system is implemented, the tower will continue to be used by the Missouri Water Patrol.
