It was purchased by Family Court Division on 12/29/95 for \$53,000.00. The improvement on this property was built in 1910, as a 3-story, single-family residence and is approximately 2,309 Ft ² . Family Court used this property as a residential facility for juvenile males under their supervision.					
	Property 2: 3221 Campbell St., Kansas City, MO 64109. Parcel #29-840-16-08-00-0-00-000. Legal description: Linwood Avenue Heights Resurvey, S 17' Lot 6 and N 17' Lot 7, situated in Jackson County, Missouri. This memo is to request to declare two properties, owned by Jackson County, Missouri, as surplus and requesting disposal of these properties.

The two properties are:

1. 3223 Campbell St., Kansas City, MO 64109. Parcel #29-840-16-09-00-00-000. Legal description: The South 33 feet of lot 7, Resurvey of Linwood Avenue Heights, a subdivision in Kansas City, Jackson County, Missouri. This parcel was purchased by the Family Court Division on 12/29/95 for \$53,000.00. The house on this parcel was built in 1910, as a 3-story, single-family residence. It is approximately 2,309 ft². Family Court used this property as a residential facility for juvenile males under their supervision.

2. 3221 Campbell St., Kansas City, MO 64109. Parcel #29-840-16-08-00-0-00-000. Legal description: Linwood Avenue Heights Resurvey, S 17' Lot 6 and N 17' Lot 7, situated in Jackson County, Missouri. Family Court purchased this vacant lot from Land Trust on 11/15/01 for the amount of \$300.00. The lot has been mostly paved to provide additional parking at 3221 Campbell St.

The Courts vacated the property several years ago after a small fire broke out in the basement of 3223 Campbell St. and caused some superficial damage. Today, neither the County nor the Courts have a need for this property. Therefore, I am requesting the property to be declared surplus and disposed of in accordance with Jackson County Code Chapter 11.

We are planning to auction the properties. It is our intent to utilize the proceeds from this sale toward program funding for Constructing Futures 2016 recognizing that all proceeds must first go to the General Fund.
