AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$21,000.00 from the undesignated fund balance of the 2014 Federal Forfeiture Fund and awarding a contract for the furnishing of four 2012 Dodge Charger police vehicles to the Missouri State Highway Patrol, at an actual cost to the County of \$63,000.00, as an acquisition from another government.

ORDINANCE NO. 4699, December 8, 2014

INTRODUCED BY Crystal Williams, County Legislator

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office desires to purchase four 2012 Dodge Chargers from the Missouri Highway Patrol to add to its fleet of emergency vehicles; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 1030.2 Jackson County Code, 1984, the Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends award of a contract to the Missouri State Highway Patrol for the furnishing of the fleet vehicles, as an acquisition from another government, at an actual cost to the County of \$63,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, the Sheriff's Office desires to use Federal Forfeiture Funds to partially fund the costs of these vehicles; and,

WHEREAS, an appropriation is necessary to place funds available in the Federal Forfeiture Fund in the proper spending account; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the following appropriation from the undesignated fund balance of the 2014 Federal Forfeiture Fund be and hereby is made:
