RE: TED System as Term and Supply Vendor

The I.T. Department is interested in adding TED Systems as a Term and Supply Vendor for the County based on their Co-Operative agreement with Clay County.

The County does not currently have a vendor in place to add miscellaneous Lenel certified security devices and cameras to our facilities unless a formal bid is sent out. This process is time consuming and does not always meet the time lines that the County needs the project completed in.

TED Systems has gone through the formal bid process for a Lenel Term and Supply contract with Clay County. This bid has a Cooperative Procurement with Other Jurisdictions clause in it so that other governmental entities can purchase off of it.

Jackson County will be adding a Term and Supply section to our next formal bid to renew the Maintenance for our Lenel system but until that time the County is left without an efficient way to quickly add the parts and pieces that come up on a regular basis.

The I.T. Department feels it would be in the Counties best interest to add TED System as a Term and Supply Vendor until the formal bid process is completed next year. We are estimating the usage cost to the County to be approximately \$30,000.00. This cost in influenced by the desire to get the camera's and security system out at the Public Works Vehicle Service Facility back in working order.

THIS CONTRACT, MADE THIS 3 day of coroser 2011, is herein called Term & Supply Contract for Electronic Security and Life Safety Components Services and Systems between Clay County, Missouri (hereinafter "County") and Ted Systems, LLC, licensed to do business in the state of Kansas, hereinafter referred to as "Supplier".

WHEREAS, County has caused to be prepared, General Terms and Conditions, Special Conditions and/or Specifications, Invitation for Bid, Term and Supply Contracts and any special bid clauses/addenda listed under Special Attachments below (hereinafter "Contract Documents"), said contract documents setting forth such equipment, supplies, labor and/or services to be furnished as therein fully described; and

WHEREAS, Supplier did on the 22nd day of September 2011, file with the County their Bid to furnish such equipment, supplies, labor and/or services, as specified, and,

WHEREAS, the aforementioned documents adequately and clearly describe the terms and conditions upon which the Supplier is to furnish such equipment, supplies, labor and/or services as specified, IT IS AGREED,

- 1. Clay County, Missouri, acting through its Purchasing Agent does hereby accept, with modifications, if any, the Bid of <u>Ted Systems, LLC</u>. (Supplier).
- 2. That a copy of the Supplier's signed Bid is attached. The Supplier's Bid and the County's Contract Documents become the contract between the parties hereto; that both parties hereby accept and agree to the terms and conditions of said bid documents, and that the parties are bound thereby and that the compensation to be paid the Supplier is as set forth in the Supplier's Bid. - 3. That this Contract shall be effective only after being approved by Clay County Commission action. Bid No. 42-11, Contract period from October 31, 2011 to October 30, 2012. The County may, at its option, renew the Contract for up to four (4) additional one-year contract periods by giving written notice to the supplier. Any increase in cost at the beginning of each renewal period will be limited to the current Federal Price Index "CPI-U, All Items" (Urban Consumers Index CPI Rate).
- 4. No financial obligation shall accrue against the County until Supplier makes delivery pursuant to order of the Purchasing Agent and/or his approved designee.
- 5. This Contract may be terminated by either party upon sixty (60) days prior notice in writing to the other party. The County may terminate this contract immediately, under breach of contract, if the Supplier fails to perform in accordance with the terms and conditions as referenced to and incorporated above. In the event of any termination of contract by the Supplier, the County may purchase such supplies and/or services similar to those so terminated, and for the duration of the contract period the Supplier will be liable for all costs in excess of the established contract pricing.
