Bob Spence, County Legislator, said he recieved a letter from Mid-America Regional Council (MARC) regarding a bill introduced extending charges for emergency telephone service "911" to cell phone users. Currently, Missouri has no legislation mandating a "911" service fee for cell phone users. Therefore, those with home phone service pay the majority of the "911" cost in most counties. With more Missourians disconnecting their home phone services, the problem is getting worse.
