



<p>REQUEST SUMMARY</p>	<p>A resolution authorizing the County Executive to execute agreements with certain outside agencies funded by the County's Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund for the 2019 fiscal year, which are engaged in anti-drug and anti-violence, activities and purposes, to provide a local match to federal, state, local and/or private grant funds, at an aggregate cost to the county not to exceed \$1,061,775.00.</p> <p>Exhibit A indicates the outside agencies and funding levels as recommended. These recommendations have been reviewed by the Jackson County Drug Commission and approved for submission to the Jackson County Legislature for 2019 fiscal year.</p> <p>Background: The Anti-Drug Tax Fund authorizes the County to execute agreements and contracted service for purpose of providing substance abuse treatment, prevention, grant match and other anti-drug, and anti-violence initiatives in the community. These recommendations are based upon applications submitted by community providers for grant match funding. Each applicant must indicate that they receive federal, state, local or private matching funds. Each proposal was reviewed and scored by at least two independent outside evaluators. COMBAT staff also considered compliance and outcomes data to determine an overall score. These funding recommendations were reviewed by the Jackson County Drug Commission on March 12, 2019, with recommendation that they be presented to the Jackson County Legislature.</p>
