**A RESOLUTION** transferring \$50,050.00 within the 2012 Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund to cover funding for the Sheriff's Office's 2012 Drug Abuse Resistance Education (DARE) program.

WHEREAS, by Resolution 17807, dated January 30, 2012, the Legislature did authorize the allocation of one-half of the budgeted Anti-Drug Sales Tax funds for the Sheriff's Office's 2012 Drug Abuse Resistance Education (DARE) program, and;

WHEREAS, the COMBAT Administration now recommends that the remaining balance of \$50,050.00 in the Sheriff's Office's Anti-Drug Sales Tax Fund be transferred to its 2012 DARE program; and,

WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended said transfer; now therefore,
