ORDINANCE NO. 6090, June 1, 2026

INTRODUCED BY Manuel Abarca IV, Venessa Huskey, and Donna Peyton, County Legislators

WHEREAS, the Parks + Rec Department has need for the installation of a WWII Veterans Memorial that will be located at the Downtown Oppenstein Brothers Memorial Park; and,

WHEREAS, the new structure will be installed at the proposed location of Oppenstein Brothers Memorial Park by Frisbie Monuments of Independence, MO; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 1030.1 of the Jackson County Code, the Interim Director of Finance and Purchasing recommends the award of contract for installation services to Frisbie Monuments of Independence, MO as a sole source purchase for the reason that it is the proprietary manufacturer of the needed structure/monument; and,

WHEREAS, an appropriation and transfer of funds within the 2026 Park Fund is required to place the necessary funds in the proper spending account; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the County Legislature of Jackson County, Missouri, that the following transfer and an appropriation be and hereby are made:

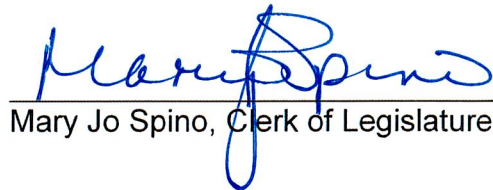

Frisbie Monuments of Independence, MO is needed for installation of a WWII Veterans Memorial at the proposed location of Oppenstein Brothers Memorial Park in Downtown Kansas City, MO.

Frisbie Monuments of Independence, MO has been a source for memorial structure and installation services for Jackson County because other companies that offer similar services were not local. Being that Frisbie Monuments of Independence, MO, is local gives better access and support to locally owned businesses in the Jackson County area.

The County Executive's Office requests this service for the amount not to exceed \$25,000.00 to be considered a sole source purchase. To bid and implement other outside services would be time prohibitive and counterintuitive from a financial, regional, and human capital perspective.
