

### Addendum to Outside Agency Funding Request for Jackson County 2010

Program 1 – Community Luncheon: The Luncheon will focus on identifying health problems and focus on a plan to address these problems in the future. We are proposing to draw funds from the health fund and to target Youth and Young Adults. We will make a concentrated effort to reach Church Groups, College Youth Organizations and other groups working with youth and young adults. We plan to draw \$35,000.00 from the health fund.

**Program 2 – Artist Tribute:** This program will focus on positive envolvement by young people. We will focus on performances that present an alternative to drug use, abuse and drug trafficing. We will target young people who have talent and provide programing which has a positive message. We hope to encourage young people to avoid jail time and negative behavior in the community. We hope to draw support from Combat Anti-Drug Funds. Budget for this program is \$15,000.00.

**Program 3 – Interfaith Service:** This final program we plan to do a collaberation between the health fund and the combat anti-drug program. We propose to bring together the young and the old and the people of all faiths. We will look at how we have addressed health, environment and violence in the past and how we plan to address these issues in the future. We will provide a forum to present various points of view with full participation from a wide sector of age groups and faith groups. We will draw \$5,000.00 from the Health Fund and \$5,000.00 from Combat Anti-Drug Program. The budget draw for this program will be \$10,000.00.
