The agreements are intended to support anti-crime initiatives, crime prevention, treatment programs, and school-based law enforcement activities. Transferring \$1,551,891.00 from treatment (56006) to prevention (56005). Transferring \$74,451.00 from LESBI (56007) to prevention (56005). With an appropriation of \$553,987.00 from the Anti-Crime Sales Tax undesignated fund balance to prevention (56005). Not to exceed \$13,839,340.00.

COMBAT funding is dedicated to building strong and safe communities across Jackson County by addressing the threats posed by illegal drugs and violent crime. This is achieved through a comprehensive approach that includes prevention, treatment services, and support for the criminal justice system. This resolution authorizes the County Prosecutor to execute agreements with

selected outside agencies, funded by the County’s Anti-Crime Sales Tax Fund, for fiscal year 2026. These agencies are engaged in anticrime and anti-violence prevention efforts, treatment programs, and school-based law enforcement initiatives. Total funding for these agreements shall not exceed \$13,839,340.00. The funding categories are as follows:
