DETENTION CENTER POPULATION

After consideration and input from the jail population committee which consists of representatives from the Circuit Court, the Prosecuting Attorney's Office, the District Public Defender's Office, the Kansas City Missouri Police Department, and the County administration including the Corrections Department and Office of Population Control, a working population cap of 835 inmates at the Jackson County Detention Center is hereby implemented. County staff is directed to manage the inmate population at the Jackson County Detention Center through implementation of appropriate policies and procedures formulated in the interests of protecting the public safety and in cooperation with the jail population committee. Nothing in this Executive Order shall be interpreted as a limitation on the powers and duties of the Court, the ability of the Corrections Department to manage and operate the Detention Center, or the ability of any concerned party to adopt and implement short term, emergency or contingency plans related to population management.
